## Ready to Explore French Polynesia on *The Gauguin*?

- **More Than 14 Days Prior:** Complete the vaccination process
- **30 to 6 Days Prior:** register with the French Polynesian government by filling out an Electronic Travel Information System (ETIS) form online and upload your proof of vaccination; print a receipt and boarding authorization form
- **Within 3 Days of Departure:** take a Covid-19 RT-PCR test
- **Day of Flight:** present the ETIS form receipt, your vaccine card and the negative results to your Covid-19 RT-PCR test
- **Arrive Tahiti:** complete a rapid (antigen) test at the Faa'a International Airport in Tahiti and collect your Covid-19 self-test kit to be taken on day 4 of your stay in the islands
- **Arrive the m/s *Paul Gauguin*:** present vaccine card, negative Covid-19 RT-PCR test results and the completed health declaration form sent to you with your cruise documents
- **Day 4 in Tahiti:** self-test and turn into reception
- **Return Flight:** complete an antigen rapid test at the Faa'a International Airport in Tahiti

## Safety On Board the m/s *Paul Gauguin*

Whether on land or on board, your safety is our primary concern. As scientific advances are made, Paul Gauguin Cruises continues to hone its robust protocol to guarantee an optimal experience by integrating all the technological, personal and physical (material) measures to ensure the provision and maintenance of an uncontaminated zone. This reinforced protection is based on three “shields” designed to guarantee solid onboard access conditions, strict hygienic protocol, and daily regulation and monitoring of guests, equipment, and the ship in general.



## Conditions of access to board the *The Gauguin*

All guests and crew are checked and subject to this hygienic safe zone protocol



### 14 DAYS PRIOR

Vaccination must be completed a minimum of 14 days prior to travel



### 3 DAYS PRIOR

Take a Covid-19 RT PCR test



### AT BOARDING

Present vaccine card, negative Covid-19 RT-PCR test results, and a completed health declaration form to ship staff

## Boarding, or refusal if:

Traveler will be denied if: 1.) unable to prove complete vaccination at least 14 days before boarding 2.) their vaccination is beyond the period of valid immune protection according to the guidelines defined by the Haute Autorité de Santé on the day of boarding 3.) vaccine is not in accordance with HAS recommendations 4.) yields positive test results 5.) the test was conducted outside of the 72 hour timeline 6.) they have come into contact with a Covid-19 case in the previous 14 days 7.) their temperature is over 100.4° F / 38° C or 8.) symptoms are detected.



## Preservation of the onboard hygienic safety zone

All passengers and crew are subject to health protocol and all onboard spaces are disinfected on a regular basis



**DISINFECTION**  
of baggage and cargo



**PASSENGERS**  
Utilize provided safety kits and wear a mask while outside cabin



**CLEANING**  
of all spaces and disinfection of the renewed air



**BARRIER GESTURES**  
Physical distancing and systematic temperature monitoring



**CREW**  
Mandatory wearing of a mask or visor



**ISOLATION ZONE**  
available if necessary (3 cabins)



## SHORE VISITS<sup>(1)</sup>

The ship tender will be disinfected and passengers will observe reinforced health instructions: social distancing, wearing a mask, barrier gestures, hand disinfection and temperature measurement in order to reboard *The Gauguin*.

## Control of the hygienic safety zone

We have a highly-developed system for monitoring and controlling the health status on board *The Gauguin* in order to guarantee you a safe visit to the islands



### MEDICAL TEAM

Doctor and nurse on board



### ONBOARD HOSPITAL

Daily monitoring and rapid diagnosis with the ability to conduct Covid-19 RT-PCR and/or antigen rapid testing on board



### SAMPLING

of high-traffic surfaces on a regular basis



### CONTINUOUS MONITORING

of passengers and ship



### AFTER DISEMBARKATION

Medical questionnaire to be completed 3 weeks after cruise
