


**CROWN OF JORDAN – Oman Optional Post-Tour**  
**November 15 - 21, 2026**

**SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 15 – AMMAN**

Upon arrival at Amman Queen Alia airport, you will be met by a **Ya'Ila Tours USA** Jordan representative before the immigration desk in the airport. He will be holding a sign with your names, then he will assist you with arrival procedures and pay for visa on your behalf after that he will go with you to identify your luggage and take you to the arrival hall where your driver is waiting to transfer you to your Amman hotel for the balance of the day at leisure and overnight.

Our hotel, **SIGNIA BY HILTON**, is located in the business district of Amman. All 272 guest rooms are equipped with air-conditioning, complimentary Wi-Fi, satellite TV, minibar and hair dryer. Facilities and services include several restaurants, 24-hour room service, a health club with spa and outdoor pool, and a very large entertainment center with a bowling alley.

**MONDAY, NOVEMBER 16 – AMMAN**

After breakfast, visit the **Roman Theater** of Amman and the Citadel.

Stroll through the old markets in the downtown area and stop to sample some knafeh, a regional treat, from the famous **Habibah Sweets**.

Then, drive to **Jerash**, one of the world's best-preserved ancient Roman cities, located in the fertile heights of Gilead. Stroll the stately colonnaded streets past the theater, the baths, the hill-top temple and the triumphal arch.

Lunch en route.

Return to Amman and we will end the day with a unique experience: meet a **Jordanian matchmaker** in her house. Jordanians still turn to old customs when it comes to finding a spouse. Finding love is a priority as family remains a pillar of stability in the country. Return to the hotel for overnight.

**TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 17 – PETRA**

Drive to nearby **Mt. Nebo**, the traditional burial site of Moses overlooking the Dead Sea and the Jordan Valley. See the magnificent mosaics dating back to the 6th century.

Continue to the holy city of **Madaba**, known for outstanding Byzantine mosaics.

Visit **St. George's Cathedral** and see the 6<sup>th</sup>-century mosaic floor depicting the earliest surviving map of the Holy Land.

Lunch in Madaba.

Drive through the scenery of Wadi Mujib to **Kerak** to visit the crusader castle. Continue to Petra for dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Our hotel in Petra, **OLD VILLAGE RESORT**, is a 4-star DRY hotel built in the style of a local 19<sup>th</sup>-century village. Guest rooms are comfortably rustic, combining the charm of the past with the modern comforts and facilities of today such as climate control, free Wi-Fi, minibar, and hair dryer. Hotel amenities include an indoor swimming pool, sauna, free Wi-Fi, and a restaurant.

## **WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 18 – PETRA**

This morning we will tour the city of **Petra**. Lost to the world for centuries in the mountains of southern Jordan, this “rose-red city half as old as time,” was discovered by the Swiss explorer Burkhardt in 1812. Once it was a stronghold and capital for the Nabateans, but fell to Rome in 106 A.D. Travel part of the way on horseback and the rest on foot through the deep and narrow passage known as the siq. (**As a great deal of walking is included in the visit, we suggest good walking shoes and a lightweight jacket.**)


As the siq opens onto the ancient city, the magnificent **Treasury** appears immediately in front of you, an awesome start to an unforgettable experience.

Now we begin our exploration of what both the Nabateans and Romans left for us to witness. The most adventurous will be invited to hike up to the spiritual “High Place,” site of the sacrificial alter, which offers a spectacular view of the ancient city and surroundings.

Return to your hotel for overnight.

**Dinner** – At 7:30pm drive to **Petra Kitchen**, where you will learn how to cook some Jordanian dishes and then dine on your own creations.

## **THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 19 – DEAD SEA**

Depart Petra to visit **Shobak Castle**, another in the great chain of Crusader fortresses which stretches across Jordan. The stronghold, known as Mont Realis (Montreal), was constructed in 1115 CE by Baldwin I. At its height, Shobak was home to about 6,000 Christians. It suffered

numerous assaults by Saladin before it finally fell to him in 1189. Shobak Castle was then restored by the Mamluks in the 14th century. The castle is perched on top of a small hill northeast of the town of Shobak. Inside the fortress there are two churches, ruins of baths, cisterns and rainwater pipes, in addition to millstones for pressing olives, a few archways and other works, which have stood the test of time. The caretaker can point out a shaft from which a set of stairs cut into the rock leads down to a spring below the castle. The shaft has 375 steps and is one of the deepest wells ever cut by Crusader forces.

Visit "**Bethany Beyond the Jordan**" excavations of the baptism site of Jesus and the place where Elijah ascended to heaven in a chariot of fire.

Arrive at your Dead Sea hotel for the balance of the day at leisure and overnight.

Hotel facilities and services include a variety of restaurants (from Thai to Italian), the longest private beach in Jordan, 8 outdoor freshwater swimming pools, a tennis court and a gymnasium, a business center, concierge team, and luxury airport transfers. The Ishtar Spa by Resense is a real highlight, offering "Ishtar Baths", including indoor and outdoor swimming pools, a whirlpool, Dead Sea pools, a sauna, a steam room, showers, a hydro-pool, a hammam and Tepidarium heated lounges. The hotel has a separate ladies-only hydro-facilities. Hydro facilities are free when you book a treatment, or when you register for our Day Spa experience.
